11 Shimodate Museum of Art

The Shimodate Museum of Art houses and exhibits a collection of works by artists associated with the local region, including the potter Hazan Itaya and the oil painter Shigeru Morita, both of whom are recipients of the Order of Culture, Isao Onishi, a lacquer artist designated as the holder of Important Intangible Cultural Property (Living National Treasure), and Tesshin Asaka, a calligrapher awarded the Japan Art Academy Award. It also holds various special exhibitions. Opening hours: 10:00 - 18:00 Closed: Monday (or the following day if the Monday falls on a national holiday)

3 Haguro Shrine



Haguro Shrine was established in 1481 when Katsuuji Mizunoya, the lord of Shimodate Castle, transferred a divided tutelary deity of Haguro-no-Okami in Dewa Sanzan. It is a historic shrine with a number of designated cultural properties of the prefecture, including its main hall and a standing statute of the Atago Myojin deity.

2 Hazan Itaya Museum



This museum is dedicated to honoring the achievements made by Hazan Itaya, the first potter to receive the Order of Culture. Visitors can see his excellent works and related materials, along with the house where Hazan was born and the kiln built by the potter himself that was relocated from his studio in Tabata, Tokyo.

and "Hosui" along with the "Shinko" that is larger in size. The best season for pears runs from summer to autumn.


Hello Cycling


